CONSENT / HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

As a parent or legal guardian of the child named on this form, I hereby give my full consent and approval for my child to participate as a team member in the Bridgman Softball Association.

I understand that there are certain risks of injury inherent in the practice and play of this sport, as well as in traveling, and other related activities incidental to my child's participation. I am willing to assume these risks on behalf of my child. I hereby certify that my child is fully capable of participating in the designated sport and that my child is healthy, and have no physical or mental disabilities or infirmities that would restrict full participation in these activities, unless otherwise noted on this form.

In addition to giving my full consent for my child's participation, I do hereby waive, release, and hold harmless the Bridgman Softball Association, its officers, coaches, umpires, sponsors, supervisors, and representatives, for any injury that may be suffered by my child in the normal course of participation in the designated sport, and the activities incidental thereto, whether the result of negligence, or any other cause.

I take full responsibility for the return of any and all equipment, fund raiser merchandise, and/or money that is issued to my child which is due to be returned to his/her coach, or team. I understand that any equipment or merchandise issued to my child which is not returned within a reasonable period of time, and any dues owed to the Bridgman Softball Association, be it registration fees or fund raiser money, will be made whole, or my child may be required to forfeit playing time until restitution is made.

I confirm that the information provided on this form is accurate. I understand that the players registered on this form are not considered registered until payment has been received. Registration fees are NON-REFUNDABLE. Request for pairing of players on a specific team will not be allowed. Applicants can make travel arrangements, if necessary, after the teams are established. Parent or guardian will be required to work the concession stand at a home event once per child registered. Coaches reserve the right to ask spectators to leave the field for unsportsmanlike conduct.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS, COACHES, PARENTS, AND SPECTATORS:

Before a participant is allowed to begin practice or competition she and a parent or guardian is required to read the code of conduct. In addition to following the rules which apply to each age group, all participants, coaches, parent(s), and spectators are expected to follow this Code of Conduct. The following actions may result in a verbal or written warning, suspension from participation, or expulsion from the softball program:

1. Cursing or inappropriate language.
2. Fighting or threatening.
3. Arguing with coaches or game officials.
4. Harassing, criticizing, or making fun of others.
5. Verbal or physical abuse.
6. Throwing equipment or other items to express anger.

All participants are expected to be on time for games in their complete uniform and required equipment. Participants that are signed up for softball are expected to participate in scheduled games and practices.
